2006 Pouilly-Fumé and Sancerre Vintage Report

A cool spring delayed budburst, but this was followed by a warm June and a hot July, causing fears that the grapes may lose freshness. Fortunately a cool August allowed the grapes to develop acidity to balance sugar levels. September was a little damp, so harvests had to be brought in quickly to prevent rot. Many good growers were able to cope with the years chaotic growing season and produced Sauvignons that are subtle, elegant and aromatic.
