Wine description

An exclusive of Maison Louis Latour (monopole), the Château de Blagny is located high on the hillside overlooking the villages of Meursault and Puligny-Montrachet. A wonderful wine traditionally vinified and matured in small oak barrels. It displays all the attributes of an exemplary white Burgundy showing oppulence and a mineral freshness coupled with rich, fat flavours that develop overtime.

Tasting note

Pale gold in color, this wine offers a developed nose marked by peppery mint and white flower scents. Full wine, fresh and very powerful in the mouth. The floral and mineral notes are accompanied by citrus flavors on the final. Beautiful length.
