Wine description

Nuits Saint Georges is the most southerly village in the Côte de Nuits. The village was originally called Nuits but added Saint Georges, the name of one of its finest vineyards, in the 19th century. There are no Grand Crus in this village. The wines tend to be firm and usually benefit from a few years ageing.

Tasting note

An intense, deeply coloured wine, showing pronounced, complex fruit of cherries, blackcurrants and violets, with truffles and spices. Subtle and integrated oak flavours on the palate with peppery notes, this wine is medium bodied, concentrated and admirably long on the finish.
