Wine description

The fruit is sourced from the Rocky Road Vineyard which lies in the headwaters of the Chapman Brook, near Witchcliffe in the south of the Margaret River region. Vineyard management takes a back to basics approach at McHenry Hohnen embracing sustainable 'Old School' practices that were used before the rise of intense agriculture.

Tasting note

On the nose lifted aromas of cherry conserve, violets and cassis with underlying sweet

liquorice, black olives and dark chocolate. Forest fruits fill a silky palate that abounds with cassis and savoury tobacco notes. The silky mid-palate is supported by firm yet

velvety tannins and light cedar notes.
