Established in 1781 in the Northern Rhône Valley, Vidal-Fleury is the oldest continuously operating winery in the Rhone Valley. Syrah & Viognier come from terraces mainly on the Côte Brune and the Côte Blonde.

Tasting note

Red with some carmine glint in the glass. The wine has fresh fruits, violet, pepper, smoky and black olive aromas. The palate is rich and full bodied with good balance. It has red fruit, blackcurrant, spice flavours with a persistent finish.
