GSM Vidal-Fleury

Vintage Country of Origin Region Grape varieties 2017 France Southern Rhône Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre

Wine description

Established in 1781 in the Northern Rhone Valley, Vidal-Fleury is the oldest continuously operating winery in the Rhone Valley. GSM wine is a traditional blend of the region's 3 most popular varietals - Grenache (50%), Syrah (30%) and Mourvedre (20%).

Tasting note

The nose is bright with aromas of red fruits and hints of toast. The palate is fresh and full with flavours of strawberry, cherry and undertones of pepper. The finish is long with soft tannins.
